ORDER

Before the Court is Lead Class Counsels' Motion To Extend Claims Filing to October 11, 2016 (Doc. 466).

Pursuant to Paragraph 28 of the Court's Amended Final Order and Judgment of Dismissal (D.E. 256) ("Final Judgment") this Court has continuing jurisdiction over all matters relating to the administration, consummation, and enforcement.

Pursuant to Paragraph 24 of the Final Judgment Class members were to submit "properly executed Claim Forms ... no later than 180 days after the Settlement Effective Date." This deadline is now July 11, 2016.

Pursuant to Sections 3.F.1 of the parties' Stipulation and Agreement of Compromise Settlement (D.E. 172-2) ("Settlement Agreement") Defendants were to provide the Claims Administrator a database of Class member information sufficient to facilitate the issuance to

Class members Claim Forms and Escheatment Recovery Forms and Instructions (“Claims Package”).

The Claims Administrator received a database of Class member information from Defendants as referenced by the Settlement Agreement, however the database provided required repeated efforts to reconcile the data from multiple additional data sources within the Defendants’ information systems. It is anticipated that continued efforts will provide the complete information necessary to provide the Claim Package to all Class members. Due to the volume of transactions and complexities associated with the reconciliation, it has taken considerable effort and time to complete this process and a final mailing of at least 200,000 Claims Packages still must be completed.


Because of the data reconciliation discussed above, Lead Counsel requested that the Claim Deadline provided in Paragraph 24 of the Final Judgment be extended in order to give all Class members at least 90 days within which to submit their claims, to through an including October 11, 2016.

Defendants do not object to this Motion.

THEREFORE Lead Class Counsels’ Motion to Extend the Deadline for Fling of Claims Forms and Escheatment Recovery Forms and Instructions is GRANTED (Doc. 466). Paragraph 24 of the Court’s Amended Final Judgment and Order of Dismissal is amended to provide that the Claims filing Deadline is extended to October 11, 2016.
